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What is Dasond?

Linguistically, Dasond means one-tenth. Dasond is the practice of contributing 10% of one's lawful earnings as an act of gratitude and devotion to Allah. It reflects the believer's commitment to faith and community. Dasond is not only a financial contribution but also a spiritual practice that encourages generosity, responsibility, and service to others.



The Importance of Dasond

Giving from one's wealth is a sign of gratitude and obedience to Allah. Dasond reminds believers that every blessing comes from Him and should be shared with others.

"The example of those who spend their wealth in the way of Allah is like a seed that grows seven ears; in every ear are one hundred grains."

Qur'an 2:261

The Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) also emphasized generosity, honesty, and caring for others. Acts of giving strengthen communities, reduce hardship, and increase blessings in both this life and the Hereafter. Dasond therefore serves not only as a financial contribution but also as a continuous reminder of gratitude, responsibility, and service to humanity.

Dasond should always be given with a pure intention, seeking the pleasure of Allah and supporting the religious and community mission.

Who Receives Dasond?

Dasond is offered through the authorized religious institution and is used for the benefit of the community according to established religious principles.

It may be used to support:

- Religious education
- Community welfare
- Humanitarian assistance
- Maintenance of religious institutions
- Educational and charitable initiatives

The purpose of Dasond is to strengthen the community, promote service, and support activities that benefit society while fulfilling a believer's religious responsibility.

"Never will you attain righteousness until you spend from that which you love. And whatever you spend - indeed, Allah is Knowing of it."

(Surah Aal-e-Imran 3:92)

When Should Dasond Be Given?

Dasond should be offered regularly from one's lawful income as an act of gratitude and devotion. It is recommended to contribute as soon as income is received rather than delaying it.

Giving consistently helps believers develop discipline, strengthen their faith, and fulfill their religious responsibility with sincerity.

"And establish prayer and give charity, and whatever good you put forward for yourselves you will find it with Allah."

(Qur'an 2:110)

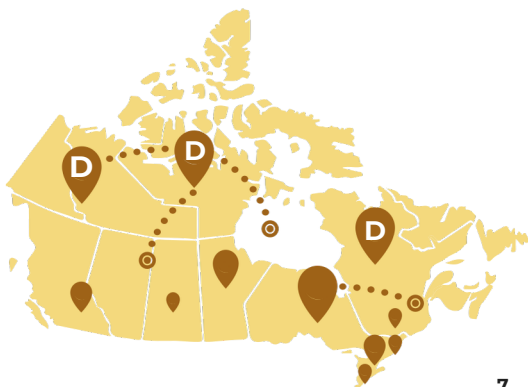
The Intention Behind Giving

Dasond should always be given with a sincere intention (Niyyah), seeking only the pleasure of Allah. It should never be offered for recognition, praise, or personal benefit. The true value of Dasond lies in the purity of one's intention and willingness to help strengthen the faith and support the community.

Making Dasond a regular habit develops generosity, responsibility, and a stronger connection with Allah throughout one's life.

"And establish prayer and give charity, and whatever good you put forward for yourselves you will find it with Allah. Indeed, Allah is All-Seeing of what you do."

(Qur'an 2:110)



How Do I Calculate My Dasond?

Dasond is generally calculated as **10% of lawful earnings or income**. Every believer should calculate their contribution honestly and accurately, ensuring that it is based only on income earned through Halal means.

The calculation should be simple, transparent, and performed with sincerity. Honest calculation reflects integrity and demonstrates gratitude for the blessings that Allah has provided.

Simple Steps to Calculate Dasond

Before calculating your Dasond:

- Determine your total lawful income.
- Exclude any unlawful or doubtful earnings.
- Calculate ten percent (10%) of the remaining amount.
- Offer the contribution with a sincere intention.
- Keep a personal record of your contribution if necessary.

Regular calculation helps believers remain consistent in fulfilling their religious responsibility while developing financial honesty and accountability.

Examples of Dasond Calculation

Monthly Income

Lawful Monthly Income	\$3,000
Dasond (10%)	\$300

Annual Income

Lawful Annual Income	\$36,000
Dasond (10%)	\$3,600

Calculation Formula

$$\text{Lawful Income} \times 10\% = \text{Dasond}$$

The amount should always be calculated from lawful earnings. If your income changes during the year, calculate Dasond according to your actual earnings. Giving honestly and accurately reflects sincerity in worship and strengthens one's commitment to faith.

Important Guidelines

Dasond should always be offered from lawful earnings with honesty, gratitude, and sincerity. It is an act of worship that reflects a believer's commitment to Allah and to the well-being of the community.

When contributing Dasond, remember the following:

- Give only from Halal earnings.
- Calculate your contribution honestly.
- Give regularly and without unnecessary delay.
- Maintain sincerity in your intention.
- Support the religious and charitable work of the community.
- Treat Dasond as an act of devotion rather than an obligation alone.

Spiritual Benefits of Dasond

Regularly contributing Dasond helps believers develop generosity, humility, and gratitude. It reminds us that every blessing comes from Allah and that wealth is a trust to be used responsibly. Through sincere giving, believers seek Allah's pleasure, strengthen their faith, and contribute toward the welfare and progress of the community.
